RELEASE OF EASEMENT INTERESTS

THIS RELEASE OF EASEMENT INTERESTS is made effective this 20th day of September, 2019, by the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, acting by and through the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture, and **M HANGING LAZY 3, LLC ("MHL3")**, a Montana limited liability company, whose address is 95 Daisy Dean Road, Wilsall, MT 59086-9403.

WHEREAS, MHL3 has donated an unrestricted and perpetual trail easement to the United States of America in Sections 11, 15, and 22, T. 4 N., R. 10 E., P.M.M, Park County, Montana, depicted on **Exhibit A** as the "New Porcupine Ibex Trail No. 267"; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Federal Management Regulation, FMR 41 C.F.R. §§ 102.75.936-938, the undersigned has determined that the United States of America has no further need to use, occupy, control, or claim an interest to the Porcupine Lowline Trail No. 267 and the North Fork Elk Creek Trail No. 195 as depicted on any Forest Service maps and crossing MHL3's property in Sections 15 and 22, T.4 N., R.10 E., P.M.M., Park County, Montana, and more accurately depicted on **Exhibit A** as "Released Easement Interest."

NOW THEREFORE, The United States of America hereby releases to MHL3 any easement interests it may have in the Porcupine Lowline Trail No. 267 and North Fork Elk Creek Trail No. 195, as shown on the attached map, **Exhibit A**. This Release of Easement Interests is executed without consideration to the Government.
